





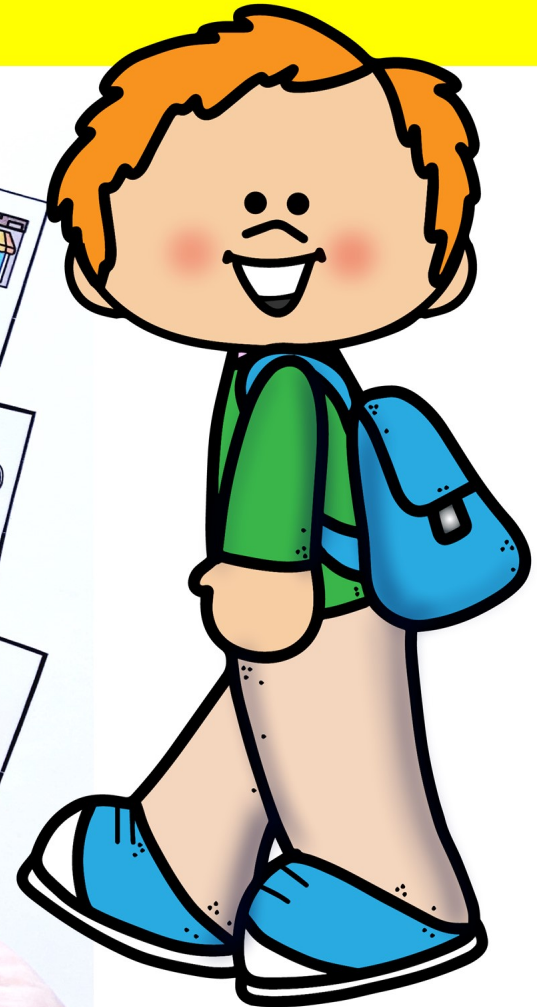

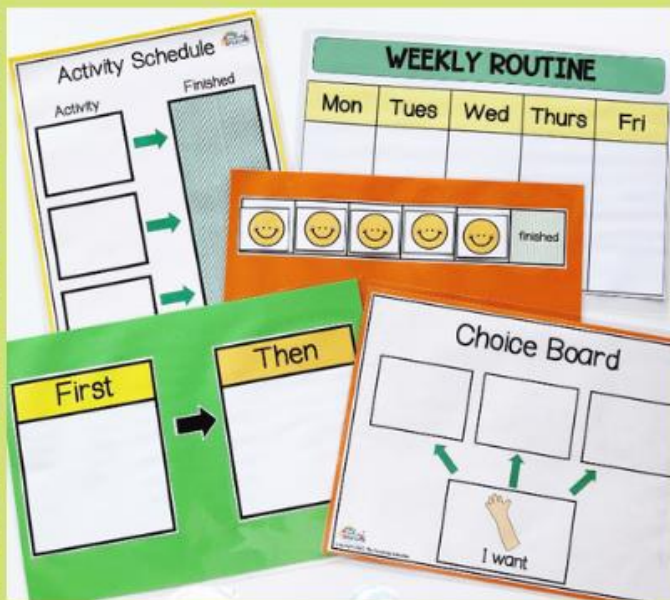

Here are just a few reasons why I LOVE using visuals every single day:

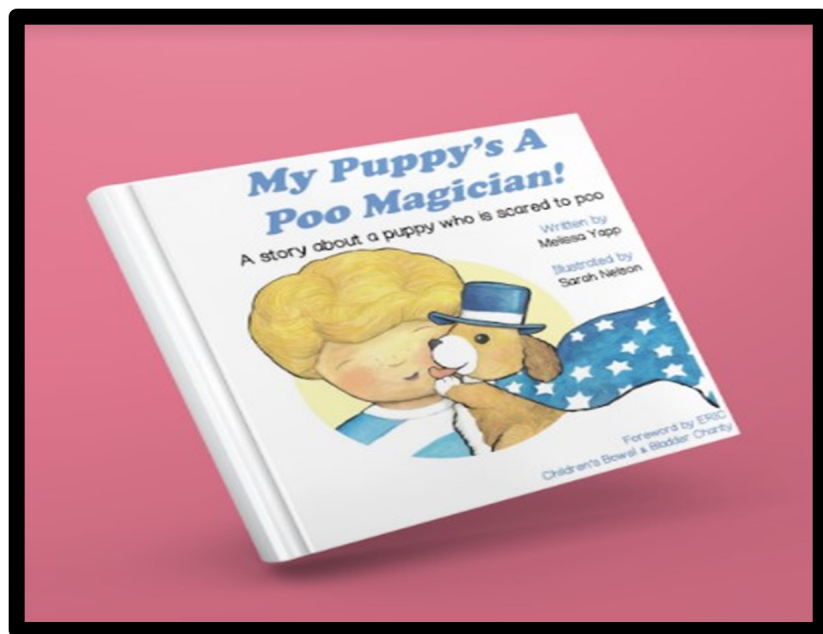
